Manufacturer Price Increase Set for Week Of April 11th

Last month, all the Shingle Manufacturers announced an 8-10% increase to cover the rising cost of fuel and materials. Understandably, this can be a discouraging change for many of us. Although, this will be the highest we have seen shingles, their increases are less volatile than the most other building materials.

Over the past two years, shingle prices have risen almost \$30 per square.

This represents almost \$1500 on a 50 square home not including the accessories that usually add around \$300.

All in, that would be \$1800 on a home that's value is up 20%, or around \$75,000. This is a fairly small increase as compared to the increased value of homes in today's market.

Thankfully, asphalt shingles certainly did not take a rise like fuel has over the last few years. If that were the case, by now roofing shingles should be valued at almost \$150 per square.

Many other building products have far surpassed the increase that we have seen in roofing products. OSB sells for over \$150 per square today, which is more than the shingles that truly protect the home. Although it is hard to accept, these increases are more manageable than as so many other items in the construction market.
